With effect from 28 June 2019, Hamish Chamberlayne and Aaron Scully now co-manage this fund.

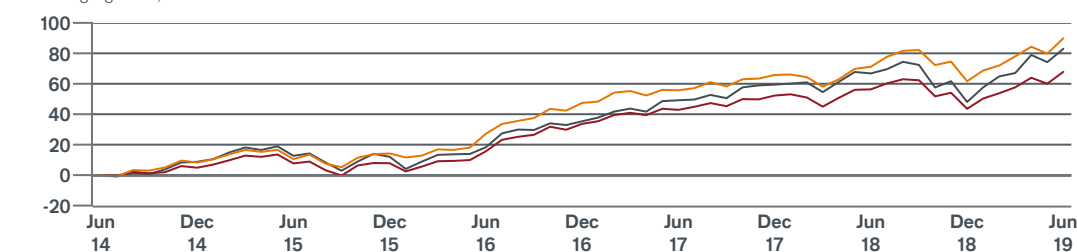
