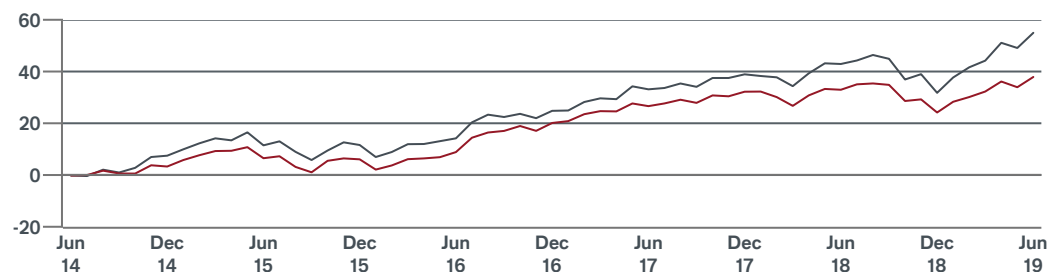

What are the risks specific to this fund?
