Objectives and investment policy

Objective

The Fund aims to provide an income in excess of the MSCI All Countries Asia Pacific Ex Japan High Dividend Yield Index, with potential for capital growth.

Investment policy

The Fund invests at least two-thirds of its total assets (after deduction of cash) in:

- Shares of companies in the Asia Pacific region (excluding Japan) in any industry

The Fund may also invest in:

- Shares of companies in other regions
- Bonds of any quality from any issuer
- Money market instruments
- Bank deposits
- Asset-Backed Securities (ABS) and Mortgage-Backed Securities (MBS)

In choosing investments, the investment manager looks for stocks that appear to be undervalued and appear to have greater potential to rise in price over the long-term than is reflected in current market prices and offer prospects for above average dividends.

The Fund may use derivatives to achieve the Fund's investment objective, to reduce risk or to manage the Fund more efficiently.

Recommendation: this Fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within 5 years.

This Fund is designed to be used only as one component in several in a diversified investment portfolio. Investors should consider carefully the proportion of their portfolio invested into this Fund.

Terms to understand

ABS and MBS A type of bond backed by the income stream from an underlying pool of assets, such as a loan or a mortgage.

Bonds Securities that represent an obligation to repay a debt along with interest.

Derivatives Financial instruments whose value is linked to the price of an underlying asset (eg indices, rates, share prices).

Money market instruments A short term debt instrument, issued by a government or company as a way to raise money. Generally considered a cash equivalent.

Shares / Equities Securities that represent fractional ownership in a company.

Volatility How sharply the Fund's share price has gone up and down over a period, generally several years.

You can buy, sell or switch units in the Fund on any business day, as defined within the "Definitions" Section of the Fund's prospectus.

The Fund offers both accumulation units (units in which net income is retained within the price) and income units (units in which net income is paid out to investors).

The value of an investment and any income from it can go up or down. When you sell your units they may be worth less than you paid for them.

The risk/reward rating above is based on medium-term volatility. In the future, the Fund's actual volatility could be higher or lower and its rated risk/reward level could change.

The share class appears at 5 out of 7. Share classes in higher categories have shown greater and/or more frequent variations in share price in the past 5 years than those in lower categories. The lowest category does not mean risk free.

The rating does not reflect the possible effects of unusual market conditions or large unpredictable events. Under normal market conditions the following risks may apply:

Derivatives and Leverage The Fund may use derivatives towards the aim of achieving its investment objective. This can result in 'leverage', which can magnify an investment outcome and gains or losses to the Fund may be greater than the cost of the derivative. Derivatives also introduce other risks, in particular, that a derivative counterparty may not meet its contractual obligations.

Exchange Rates If the Fund holds assets in currencies other than the base currency of the Fund or you invest in a share/unit class of a different currency to the Fund (unless 'hedged'), the value of your investment may be impacted by changes in exchange rates.

Liquidity Securities within the Fund could become hard to value or to sell at a desired time and price, especially in extreme market conditions when asset prices may be falling, increasing the risk of investment losses.

Charges to Capital Some or all of the Annual Management Charge and other costs of the Fund may be taken from capital, which may erode capital or reduce potential for capital growth.

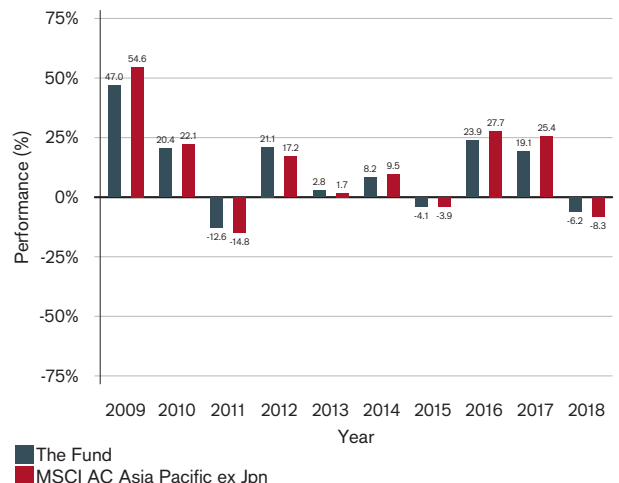
